The Winter Emergency Programme is a state offer and is aimed exclusively at homeless people who are looking for overnight accommodation free of charge and anonymously if they wish and **who have no other options for overnight accommodation or other form of self-help.**

### 1 **Overnight accommodation from Fördern & Wohnen**

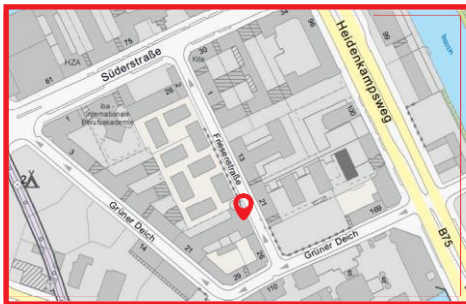
- For a free place to sleep, please directly contact one of the **overnight accommodation locations** from **Fördern & Wohnen (F&W)**:

This accommodation is also suitable for those in **wheelchairs**

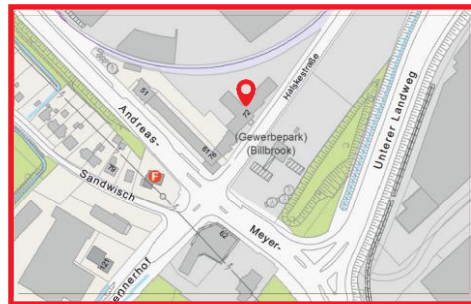

#### **Directions:**

Take **bus lines 120** or **230** to the **"Moorfleet (Halskestraße)"** stop.  
**Or:** Take the **commuter train S21** to the **"Billwerder-Moorfleet"** stop. From there, it is about a **10-minute walk**.



A **free bus shuttle from Fördern & Wohnen** will run from **Friesenstraße** to **Châu-und-Lân-Straße (Halskestraße)** in the evening. Those who stay there overnight can use a bus transfer to the city centre in the morning. Information concerning this is available at Friesenstraße.

## 1 Warming rooms

- ▶ In winter, no one should have to spend the night on the street! Homeless people who are **not entitled to a place to sleep in the accommodations from Fördern & Wohnen** are offered a nightly stay in the **warming room** at Hinrichsenstraße 4.

## 1 Day rooms

- ▶ **Where can I stay during the day?** In general, **day rooms** are available at the following facilities, for example. **Please find out in advance about possible restrictions, for example, contacting the staff of the Winter Emergency Program of Fördern & Wohnen.** There, you will also find information about other day rooms not listed here.

## 1 Consultation services

- ▶ The Winter Emergency Program offers **free social counselling**. This will help you find a way out of homelessness. Talk to the social workers at Fördern & Wohnen and **let them help you**.

In order to get a **spot at a residential accommodation**, you must first have your entitlement to social benefits checked at the **Jobcenter team.arbeit.hamburg** (Kleine Reichenstraße 2, 20457 Hamburg).

**Note:** A personal visit is possible only by prior appointment.

- ▶ The "Plata" project advises homeless people from Eastern Europe in particular. The employees speak **German, Bulgarian, English, Italian, Polish, Romanian, Russian, Slovak and Czech**.
